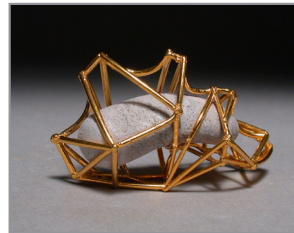


#### THE RECIPIENTS

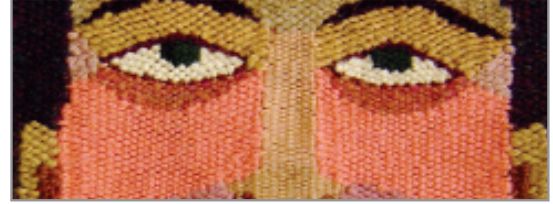

Reception & Talk: Saturday, Feb 2 from 2-4pm

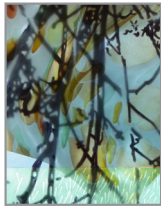
Ceramic work by alumni who have made Medicine Hat home and their cultural impact on the city.
