

## Autism Spectrum Services at UVA's Curry School of Education

*A variety of services are offered to support individuals with autism spectrum disorder and their families. These services are part of the Curry School's larger efforts to improve the lives of individuals with autism and their families through interdisciplinary research, training services, and outreach (STAR: Supporting Transformative Autism Research)*

### Autism treatment services offered:

- Parent training for managing challenging behavior and/or increasing adaptive skills (toileting, sleep, functional communication, etc.) in toddlers and children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).
- Individual therapy for children with ASD. Possible areas to be addressed in therapy include:
  - Social skills
  - Attention and organization
  - Emotional regulation
  - Symptoms of anxiety or depression
  - Daily living skills
