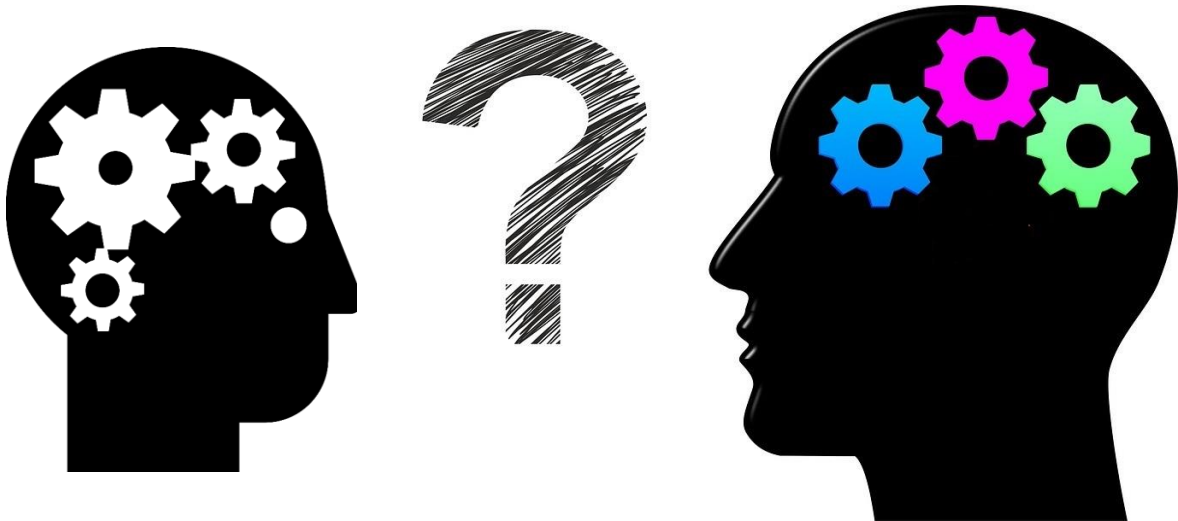


**Help us understand how to meet the educational needs of young children with autism spectrum disorder!**



## Longitudinal Study on Reading, Writing, Social, and Cognitive Development of Young Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder

- Families with a young child (ages 4 to 6) are eligible to participate in a three-year longitudinal study of reading, writing, cognitive, and social development.
- We are seeking both families with a young child with autism spectrum disorder and families with a young child without autism spectrum disorder!
- Three short (2-2.5 hour) visits per year where your child will complete a variety of games and short activities that involve using reading, writing, social communication, and cognitive abilities. Parents or guardians will be asked to fill out a few short questionnaires about their child. Families with a child with autism spectrum disorder will be asked to do one additional visit during the first year.
- Families will receive \$20 per session and will help us learn more about how to meet the educational needs of children with autism spectrum disorder.
