**IMPORTANT:** Any changes occurring due to holidays will only be effective during the week of the holiday. Your normal collection schedule will resume the week after the holiday.

## Recycling Information - Acceptable Items

- **Fiber:** cardboard, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, computer paper, office paper, telephone books, paperboard (i.e. cereal and beverage boxes).
- **Aluminum:** beverage and food cans.
- **Steel:** soup and food cans.
- **Glass bottles and jars:** green, clear, blue and brown colors accepted.
- **Plastic:** all bottles #1-7.
- **NOT ACCEPTABLE:** oil jugs, plastic bags, plastics other than bottles, window and drinking glass, pots, pans, coat hangers, tissues, paint cans.

## Yard Waste Preparation

### What is yard waste?

Garden residues, leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, sod (no more than 50 pounds), tree prunings, tree trimmings and other plant waste generated from gardening and landscaping.

### How should it be prepared?

- **Loose material:** place it in biodegradable (paper) bags or rigid containers clearly marked "Yard Waste".
- **Branches:** cut them to less than four feet in length and tie them together with string or twine in bundles less than two feet in diameter.
- **Weight Restraints:** all containers and bundles must weigh less than 50 pounds.
- **Unacceptable Items:** rocks, dirt, plastic bags (these items are trash).
