MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Mr. Offenberg: We are here to hear about the oral interviews for the Captain/Deputy Chief.

Chief Rinehart: Yes sir. In front of you, you have a memorandum where I tried to capsulize where we are at in the whole process. You will see that two people did apply that were eligible to apply out of three total eligible. Two did apply. We conducted the oral board of questions, myself, Lee Nathans and Captain Buty. We rated each individual independently. You can see they are pretty close, but we did have one clear high score.

It is my intent that once you say the word that this is a certified list, that I will offer the position to the highest score on this list.

Mr. Offenberg: Effective?

Chief Rinehart: Effective December 9th. (2011) That is the last day that the current deputy is on the job. I still have to get that approved through City Council, because even though Deputy Chief Buty is done December 9th, he is on leave until January 9th. My argument would be, I am without a Deputy Chief, and I want to go ahead and promote the Deputy Chief. The truth is, in the contract for the Sargeant, it says you will get paid for working out of rank anyway. So we do not save any money by not going ahead with the promotion. It is my intent that on that Friday, that we swear in a new Deputy Chief and a new Sargeant. The Friday of the 9th of December.

Mr. Nathans: Okay, let's put that aside and let's move ahead with this. Because if you are going to promote someone to the Seargeant's position, that's not what we are talking about now.

Chief Rinehart: Right.

Mr. Nathans: I move that we accept this.

Mr. Devine: Second.

Mr. Offenberg: Any discussion or questions or anything that anyone wants to share?

Mr. Offenberg: All in favor say I.

Mr. Nathans: Bryan Holbrook is the new Deputy Chief in place.

Chief Rinehart: Yes, well that is yet to be seen because there are some other issues and I'm not certain he will accept the job right now. This list is certified and I will offer him the job.
