

**ORDINANCE NO. 104-08**

An ordinance to appropriate \$24,253 from the unappropriated General Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing new lighting at Drexel Circle, and to declare an emergency.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY**

Section 1. That \$24,253.00 is to be appropriated from the unappropriated General Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing new lighting at Drexel Circle.

Section 2. That these funds be reimbursed to the General Fund by a combination of a grant from the Joseph A. Jeffrey Endowment Fund of The Columbus Foundation and funds from the Bexley Beautification Fund.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being the necessity of the contractor being able to order the new lights and provide lighting to Drexel Circle at the earliest possible date, and shall be in force immediately upon the passage and approval by the majority.
