

ORDINANCE NO 34-08

An ordinance to transfer \$6,105.36 from the General Fund to the Alum Creek Greenway Preservation Project Fund and to appropriate \$156,435 from the Alum Creek Greenway Preservation Fund for the purpose of recording expenses of the Alum Creek Greenway Preservation Project.

**Whereas** the City of Bexley has received financing from the State of Ohio in the form of grants totaling \$150,330 from the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Alum Creek Greenway Preservation Project; and the City has paid \$6,105 of expenses related to the project for a total project cost of \$156,435

**Whereas** payments from the State will be paid directly to the contractors; and

**Whereas** the City is required to record the amount revenue and expenditures associated with the project in a separate fund designated for recording these revenues and expenses,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That \$6,105 is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the Alum Creek Greenway Preservation Project Fund.

Section 2. That \$156,435 is hereby appropriated from the Alum Creek Greenways Project Fund for the purpose recording the expenditures associated with this project.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
