

Ordinance No. 23-08

An Ordinance to establish an encumbered fund to accept gifts and donations for the purpose of paying for costs associated with the dodgeball tournament.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is authorized and directed to establish an encumbered fund to be designated the "Dodgeball Fund" to receive donations and moneys from the public to pay costs incurred by the City in connection with the Dodgeball Tournament.

Section 2. That all moneys deposited to the Dodgeball Fund are hereby appropriated to pay the costs of the City associated with the Dodgeball Tournament sponsored by the City or in which the City participates and that the Recreation Director or his designee is authorized to expend moneys from the Dodgeball Fund for such purpose from time to time to the extent that moneys are available in such Fund.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety said emergency being the necessity of paying costs associated with the Dodgeball Tournament and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
