

**ORDINANCE NO. 06.08**

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Building Director to spend an amount up to Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) for an emergency generator for the Police Department complex and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the back-up emergency generator for the Bexley City Hall Police Department complex has been determined to be inefficient and;

Whereas the City of Bexley must maintain all essential police and safety operations for its citizens; now therefore,

Be it resolved by this Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

**Section 1.**

That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to spend a sum not greater than Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) for a new generator for the City Hall/ Police Department complex

**Section 2.**

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of maintaining electric power at the City Hall/Police Station Complex and to provide uninterrupted municipal services to City residents, and shall be in force immediately upon the passage and approval, by the majority.
