An Ordinance to authorize the hiring of a temporary assistant for a period of eight days to provide vacation coverage in the Service Department ~~and to appropriate \$5,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to Account #01-310-51010 to provide funding for the position of Secretary I (Floater) during a period in which the position is needed to cover an extended absence in the Mayor's Office~~ and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City is authorized to hire a temporary assistant for a period of eight days to provide vacation coverage in the Service Department.

~~Section 2. That \$5,000.00 is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to Account #01-310-51010 to provide funding for the position of Secretary I (Floater) during a period in which the position is needed to cover an extended absence in the Mayor's Office.~~

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare, said emergency being the need to provide appropriate staff coverage and shall go into force and be in effect upon its signing by the Mayor.
