

ORDINANCE NO. 62-07

An ordinance to appropriate \$750.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose paying for the cremation of an indigent Bexley Resident.

Whereas Morrow Funeral Home, 415 E. Court Street, Washington Courthouse, Ohio is requesting \$750.00 to reimburse them for costs incurred for the cremation of an indigent Bexley Resident and,

Whereas Section 5101.521(A) states that when the body of a dead person is found in a township or municipal corporation, and such person was not an inmate of a correctional, benevolent, or charitable institution of this state, and the body is not claimed by any person for private interment or cremation at the person's own expense, or delivered for the purpose of medical or surgical study or dissection in accordance with section 1713.34 of the Revised Code, it shall be disposed of as follows:

If the person was a legal resident of the county, the proper officers of the township or municipal corporation in which the person's body was found shall cause it to be buried or cremated at the expense of the township or municipal corporation in which the person had a legal residence at the time of death.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY


Section 1. That \$750.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the cremation of an indigent Bexley Resident.
