

ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 07

An Ordinance to amend Section 880.18 of the Business Regulation And Taxation Code to repeal the allocation of 2.5% of income tax collections to the Capital Improvements Fund, to transfer \$294,306.06 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Funds and to appropriate \$328,328 from the Capital Improvements Fund for capital improvements and new equipment during 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 880.18 of the Business Regulation And Taxation Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**880.18 ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.**

The funds collected on or after January 1 2, 007 under the provisions of this chapter shall be applied for the following purposes and in the following order:

- (a) Such part thereof as is necessary to defray all costs of collecting the taxes levied by this chapter and enforcing the provisions hereof; and
- (b) The balance of such funds shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Section 2. That Section 880.18 of the Business Regulation And Taxation Code as presently in effect is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That \$294,306.06 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 4. That \$328,328 (being the sum of the current unencumbered balance of \$34,021.94 in such fund and \$294,306.06 transferred to such fund pursuant to Section 2 hereof) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for capital improvements and new equipment during 2007 as follows:
