


### Do you feel there is enough on street parking available for your business? (Scale 1-5)


### Are current parking restrictions (i.e. time restrictions) near your business reasonable?



**Do you feel that current parking enforcement near your business is adequate?**





**If the City installed parking meters on the street near your business and charged a nominal rate for parking, do you feel this would be harmful or helpful to your business?**





**If you have your own parking lot, do you currently allow others to use it after your normal business hours?**




