Tucked between Australian Pine, and cluster of Hydrangea and Wild Cherry trees, with additional screening plantings of Vibernum.

Option A
Set immediately north and east of a Black Locust tree and surrounded by existing Spirea shrubs, with additional Vibernum added for screening.



Floor Plan View




