## Natural Gas Line Replacement Project Resumes on Ashbourne Road

Last year, we notified customers through a letter and public meeting about plans to replace the natural gas lines that serve your neighborhood. While we did begin construction in 2017, our work on Ashbourne Road was delayed in order to minimize the construction activity in the area. Next week, our contractor RLA will resume construction, and you will notice work being done on your street.

***As the project is completed on Ashbourne Road, the following steps may occur:***

- 1. MARK the right of way and existing utilities** with flags, stakes and temporary paint.
- 2. INSTALL our main line.** This pipe is usually in the tree lawn or right of way.
- 3. REPLACE our service line.** This pipe runs from the main line to the meter that serves your home or business. When we make personal contact with you, please alert us to any sprinkler systems or invisible fences.
- 4. RELOCATE any indoor gas meters** to the outside of the home or business.
- 5. RESTORE your property** including sidewalks, lawns and driveways. It may be several days or even weeks, between some of these steps.

We realize a project of this size may cause some inconveniences, and we apologize for this disruption. When our newly installed natural gas delivery system is complete it will continue to provide years of safe, reliable service to your home or business.
