The itinerary will include the following:

- Demonstrations of **state-of-the art farming equipment** in the Chamois-Morrison Bottom by the Paulsmeyer and Hackman families
- Tour of the **Townley House Museum**, one of the earliest homes, built in Chamois. in 1856. It is cared for by the Chamois Historic Preservation Commission.
- **Lunch will be provided by the Heritage Community Bank** and served at the Haystack Restaurant.
- Visit to **St. Peters UCC Church at Deer Creek**, four miles southwest of Chamois. The congregation was organized in 1865 and the first church building was erected in 1867.
- Stop at the **Chamois City Cemetery** on Highway 89 North. The magnificent view from the top of the hill overlooks the farmlands of the fertile valley to the north.
- Visit the **herd of bison** at the farm of Steve and Janice Smyth. They have had bison on their property, south of Chamois, for 18 years.

Cost for the entire day is \$35.00 per person and includes transportation by USA Tours of Rolla, guides and lunch. Meet the coach at the Osage County Community Center at 8:00 a.m. We will be **leaving PROMPTLY AT 8:30 A.M.**
