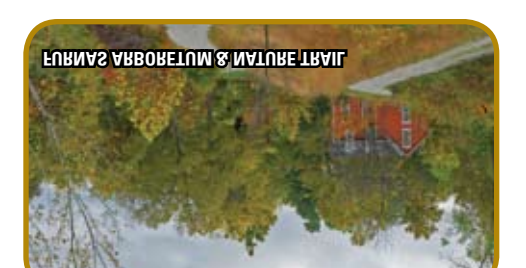

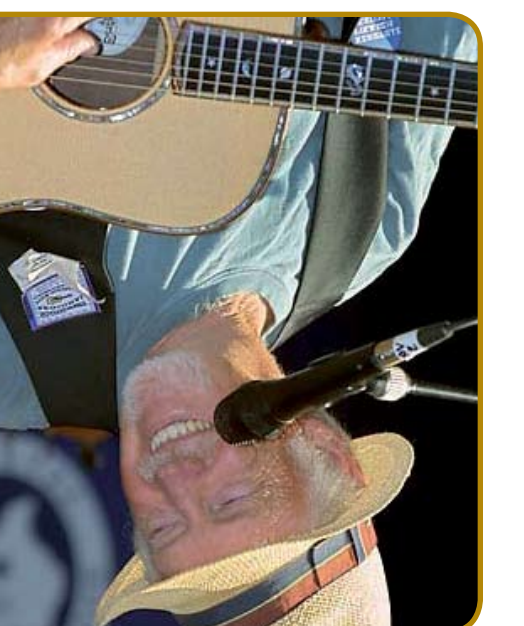

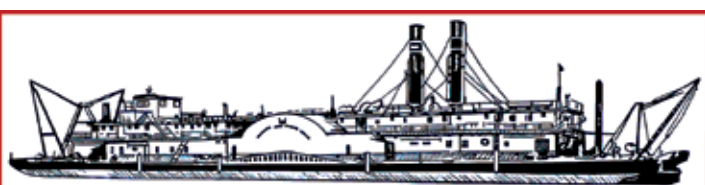

Museum of Missouri River History • A National Historic Landmark
Open 1pm to 4pm Saturdays and Sundays May through October or by appointment.
Launched in December 1931 by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, The Captain Meriwether Lewis National Historic Landmark is one of the few surviving examples of its type built to control flooding and improve navigation along the Nation's rivers.

Today the Captain Meriwether Lewis remains a historic museum vessel along the banks of the Missouri River, in the Brownville Riverside Park. It is operated by a non-profit organization, the Meriwether Lewis Foundation, and houses the Museum of Missouri River History.

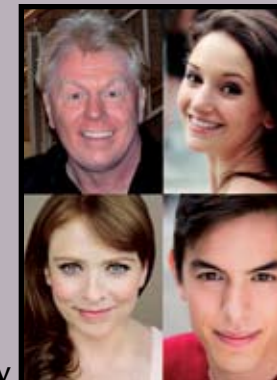
