Agriculture Day - Learn about where your food comes from on this exciting day! Extract DNA from bananas, plant your own seeds, and enjoy a muddy treat!

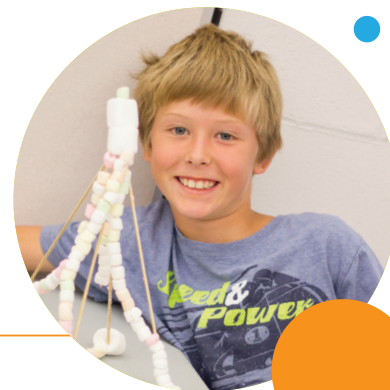
Chemistry Day - Get your hands dirty on this exciting, experimental day! We will be making chemicals change color, polyhedral bubbles, fake snot and more!

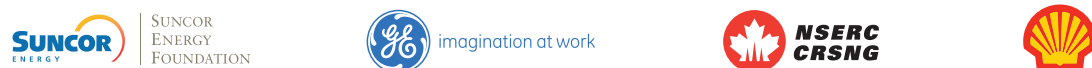
