Tourism company AndBeyond along with guests who recently visited company lodges in the Okavango delta, generously made a donation of 40 solar lights to the Sexaxa community near Maun. The guests were all from the United States, and led by Tour Leader Mark Lakin, the co-founder of "Epic Road". The guests joined the large community gathering, along with Chief Lekang and Mr Mosika, the area Councillor for Matlapaneng ward. A demonstration was given as to how to inflate and charge the lights, and explained how the solar lights would benefit and assist the community with lighting during power cuts. The added benefit would be that this would assist the children in doing their homework and ensuring lights at night. The lights, which are very easy to use, are powered by LED bulbs and give power of up to 8 hours of light when fully charged.
