

DECLARATION OF INTENT TO EARN THE REAL ESTATE CERTIFICATE

Students interested in pursuing the real estate certificate must complete 18 credits of real estate related courses. This includes 9 credits of real estate courses, 6 credits of approved real estate related electives and the academic internship (3 credits). These courses are listed on the Real Estate Certificate information sheet. Students must review these requirements with Lisa Chambers in the CU Real Estate Center to make sure they fully understand the required classes. Students who satisfactorily complete the courses and the academic internship will be awarded the Real Estate Certificate. The real estate classes offered will apply to the educational component necessary to sit for the broker's license exam in the State of Colorado.
