**1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13**

**“To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.”**

*Pentecost* [from the Greek word for “fiftieth”] is the day the Apostles discerned and accepted the power of the Holy Spirit to proclaim Jesus Christ to people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. The people listening to them came from many countries heard the Apostles in their own tongue. Amazing! More amazing is that people with a variety of religious beliefs came to believe in Jesus. Later Paul wrote to Christians in Corinth, a seaport city with people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. He told them something so obvious we often forget it: Each of us is a person with a unique array of talents, abilities and gifts that God has given to us to use for ourselves and for others - material wealth, intelligence, artistic talent, athletic ability, the gift of music, and many others. God intends for us to enjoy them ourselves and to share them with others. How are we doing with that?

**PROJECT UPDATE**  
**Project Target: \$25,000.00 Pledges Collected: \$09,350.00 Pledged: \$13,000.00 Pledges Outstanding: \$03,600.00**  
**CAMPAIGN PROGRESS: Grant Max: \$5,000.00 Request: \$5,000.00**  
Catie submitted our grant request to the Diocese for consideration. Next round of consideration will be in the fall (August-September timeframe).  
**GRANT MONEY:**  
**Ceiling Repair—\$ 10,500** (includes moving pews). (Not included in that number is the plaster repair throughout the church). Contractor has taken another job ... we are next in line.  
**Sound System Install —** We are working with Heath Eric (from Rumsey) to get this upgraded. Install will include new speakers, new sound equipment in sacristy including 1 Shure gooseneck podium mic, 2 hand-held, 1 lapel wireless mics and 1 lapel wireless mic.  
**New Lights —** New lights will be installed over the altar (which will burn brighter and cooler than what is presently there). Working with Rexell to secure the warm white, 2700K LED spot lights (similar to what is at St. Martin) for \$179.00 each ... probably will need at least 4. Working to secure the best price for new recessed LED lights to brighten up the church. The 4 existing overheads will be replaced with at least 6 (maybe 8, depending on electrician's recommendation) 3-bulb T8 LED warm white 2700K fixtures.
