This position will require overnight travel.

- > Implementing, supervising, and managing restoration projects; such as, prescribed fire and other native vegetation management work at the ground level
- > Mentoring field staff regarding ecological restoration techniques, especially prescribed fire
- > Conducting site visits, field assessments, and developing work plans
- > Preparing routine correspondence, data reports, standardized documents and work plans for internal and client review
- > Communicating, documenting, and implementing safety practices and field reports
- > Communicating with clients, contribute to add-on work from existing clients, and help identify and cultivate new client relationships
- > Adhering to corporate policies, operating through the proper management channels, and act in the best interest of the company
