Carbon & Energy (6 goals)

Vision – Madison embraces sustainable approaches to fuel our economy and community, achieving an 80% carbon reduction by 2050. Our City government and staff set examples of reduced energy use and emissions for businesses and individuals to emulate.

1. Influence reductions in transportation related carbon impacts. (12 actions)
2. Systematically upgrade existing buildings, equipment and infrastructure. (21 actions)
Public Sector (12 actions)
 - City government prioritizes and accelerates City's government building and equipment upgrade schedule.*Private Sector (9 actions)*
 - Investigate developing an energy performance level requirement for new construction or renovation of 50% or more of the gross square footage of a commercial building that could be activated at the time of plan review.
3. Improve new buildings and developments. (8 actions)
4. Engage the public in energy efficiency and climate change programs. (12 actions)
5. Obtain 25% of electricity, heating, and transportation energy from clean energy sources by 2025. (13 actions)
6. Report carbon footprint to the public. (6 actions)
