### The Benefits of an Anesthetic Portfolio: Risk Assessment to Results – 3 CEUs

To deliver optimal patient care, pain management is an essential component of periodontal therapy procedures. Supported by science, this course will provide the dental professional with the information necessary to make an anesthetic choice based on each patient's needs.

### Communicating with Confidence – 2 CEUs

But what factors drive the decision-making process of dental patients? How does confidence in communication impact patient decisions and contribute to patient retention and treatment acceptance? Why is a comprehensive hygiene examination so critical to treatment acceptance and collectively what role do these dynamics play in building patient trust and practice revenue? This course will review factors that influence dental patient's decision making and discuss the basic concepts of effective communication and relationship building. The importance of collaboration, co-diagnosis and communication between the doctor and the hygienist will be highlighted including tips for implementing an efficient, consistent and productive hygiene examination.
