

**The A, B, Cs and I, II, IIIs of Periodontitis Staging and Grading:
A Brief Review of the Latest Proposed Classification of
Periodontal Diseases and Conditions**
~ 2 hours of CE credit

This interactive presentation will introduce and discuss the proposed new classifications of periodontal diseases and conditions. This new framework of severity and complexity of periodontitis is described as a system of Staging and Grading. Stage I through Stage IV defines the severity, complexity and extent of the disease, while, Grades A, B, or C estimate the rate and likelihood of progression of the disease through direct and indirect evidence of patient risk factors.

Course Learning Outcomes:

1. Compare and contrast the 1999 Classification of Periodontal Diseases and Conditions to the 2018 proposed Classification of Periodontal and Peri-Implant Diseases and Conditions.
2. Apply the 2018 proposed Classification of periodontal diseases to patient cases.
3. Defend the value of a classification system that reaches beyond severity of past destruction and includes complexity of the disease and risk for future disease progression.
