On September 22, 2014, the Ethics Commission received your complaint alleging that former Human Rights Commissioner Nazly Mohajer hosted a campaign debt relief party in 2012 for Mayor Ed Lee, in violation of local conflict of interest rules. You also mentioned that Ms. Mohajer had been reappointed to the Human Rights Commission by the Mayor around the same time as the party.

Pursuant to Ethics Commission Regulations for Investigations and Enforcement Proceedings, section IV.A, staff conducted a preliminary review into the allegations and determined that there is reason to believe a violation of law may have occurred.

This matter has been referred to the City Attorney and District Attorney as required by the City Charter and Regulations, and both offices have advised our office that they will investigate the matter. The City Attorney and District Attorney have requested that the Ethics Commission await further notice from their office to take any further action. Therefore, at this time, the Ethics Commission's investigation has been suspended while these offices pursue their investigations.

Per the City Charter and Ethics Commission Regulations, the Ethics Commission cannot otherwise comment on the status of a complaint.
