Congratulations on being a part of the Kastner Instrumental Music Program for the 2018-2019 school year! We are looking forward to a great year and are excited that your student has chosen to be a part of our program. As you may already know, the budget dollars provided by the state to Clovis Unified do not fully fund the music programs, including the following activities or expenses:

- Additional Instructional Staff
- New Music
- Uniforms, Flags, & Other Equipment
- New Instruments, Instrument Repair, & Supplies (beyond district allotment)
- Festival Registrations
- Travel Opportunities

Through fundraising and voluntary contributions we will be able to offer these expanded opportunities. To continue to provide these opportunities through the Kastner Instrumental Music Program and, we must collectively raise the amounts necessary to cover their costs. We have estimated fundraising goals in order to continue to provide the above-described opportunities. The total voluntary donation goal for members of the Kastner Instrumental Music Program is \$21,500.

The Program's fundraising goal is a collective one, and not on an individual student basis. As such, the larger the number of students unable or unwilling to assist, the greater the burden on those students who do meet the group's fundraising goal for the benefit of everyone. Based on the collective fundraising goal, if each of the 280 students in the Kastner Instrumental Music Programs fundraises equally, the amount attributable to each student is only \$75.

We strongly encourage families and students to assist in fundraising activities and/or making voluntary donations to the program so that we can continue to offer these opportunities to Kastner students.
