Mid-Coast Fees 2013-2014 & 2014-2015

Background:

On January 28, 2003, the Board of Supervisors approved the Mid-Coast Park and Recreation Development Fees ordinance. SMC Ord. Code Chapter 2.64. The ordinance establishes mitigation fees for (1) new residential development, and (2) residential reconstruction or remodeling projects that increase the assessable space of an existing residence. §§ 2.64.030, 2.64.040. The fees collected are to be deposited in a Mid-Coast Parks Development Fund and used to acquire or develop parks that are to be located in and primarily used by Mid-Coast residents. § 2.64.060.
