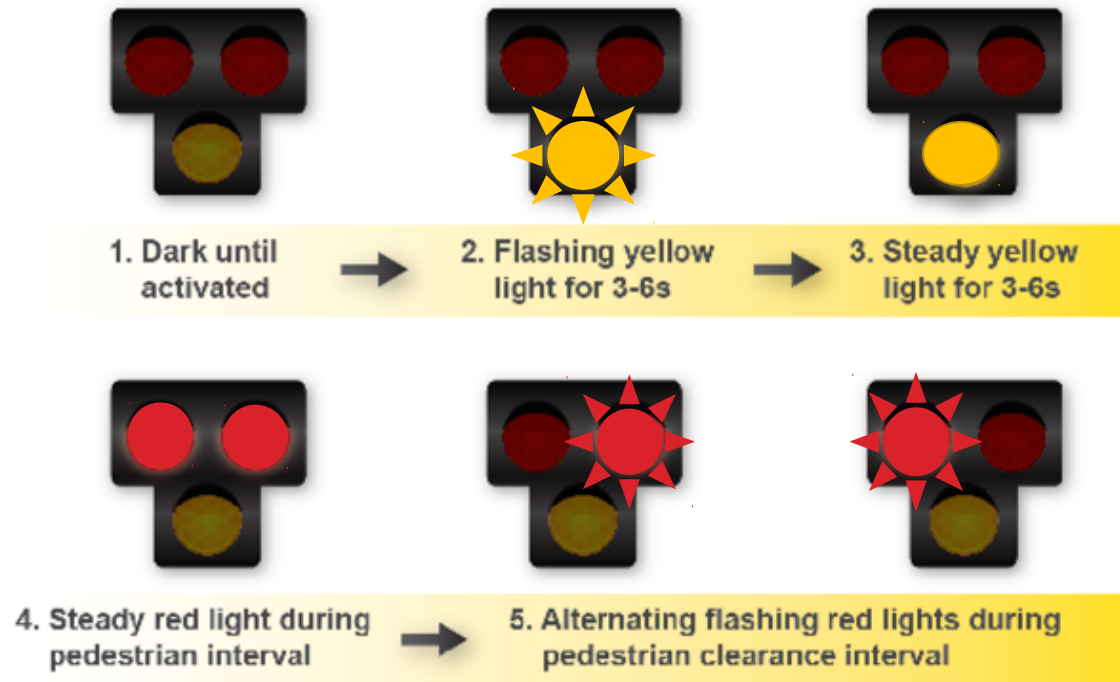


Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB)
