**Subject:** Mirada Road Pedestrian/Bike Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization

The MCC thanks you for your update on the Mirada Road Bridge Project and supports the work by San Mateo County DPW to secure initial grant funding for the project. The Mirada Road Bridge is a vital link for the California Coastal Trail, allowing pedestrian and bicycle travel between the City of Half Moon Bay and Pillar Point Harbor with continuous ocean views. The trail is heavily used by local residents and national and international visitors who come to this area. In the recent past a bridge failure on the trail in the City of Half Moon interrupted trail access for more than a year. This project will ensure that such an interruption isn't experienced in the San Mateo County Midcoast.
