1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Karno called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

PRESENT: Chair Karno, Vice Chair Grossman, Board Member Levitan, and Board Member Lotman.

ABSENT: Advisor Goss.

BBGHAD STAFF ALSO PRESENT (not Board Members and not subject to Roll Call): Clerk and Treasurer Bernadette O'Neill, Engineer Russ Boudreau and Chris Webb, and Project Counsel Ken Ehrlich. Consultant Zan Marquis and Board Member applicant Chip Rosenbloom participated by phone.

3. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Project Counsel reported that the meeting Agenda was posted at 8:35 a.m. on Thursday August 1, 2013 within the boundaries of the BBGHAD. Vice Chair Grossman moved, and Board Member Levitan seconded, the approval of the Agenda. The motion approving the Agenda passed 4-0.

4. APPROVED SUMMARY OF ACTIONS FROM JULY 14, 2013 MEETING

Project Counsel noted certain corrections for the Summary of Actions from the July 14, 2013 meeting. Subject to Project Counsel's corrections, Vice Chair Grossman moved, and Board Member Lotman seconded, the approval of the Summary of Actions from the July 14, 2013 meeting. The motion passed 4-0.

8. NEW BUSINESS

Vacancy on BBGHAD Board of Directors. Project Counsel reported that BBGHAD Board Member Zan Marquis resigned on June 14, 2013 and measures to fill this vacancy have been completed. Project Counsel briefed BBGHAD Board on the posting of the Notices of Vacancy within the BBGHAD boundaries from July 10-26, 2013 and the timely receipt of a Board member application from Dale "Chip" Rosenbloom Jr. The Chair stated that Resolution No. 2013/03 has been circulated, and asked for any comments.

MOTION: The Vice Chair moved that the resolution be adopted, and Board Member Lotman seconded the Motion. There was no further discussion. The Motion adopting Resolution No. 2013/03 passed 4-0, and Chip Rosenbloom was appointed to the Board. Mr. Rosenbloom accepted the appointment.

9. OLD BUSINESS

a. Permitting and Regulatory Process

The Chair recognized Project Counsel, who summarized the contents of a July 12, 2013 letter received from the CCC concerning the agency's position that the BBGHAD's CDP application remains incomplete. Project Counsel asserted that the BBGHAD has potential legal and technical responses to this latest letter. The Chair recognized the Vice Chair, who asserted that: a) review of the CCC's multiple "incomplete application" letters to the BBGHAD suggests that a number if permit application items remain incomplete, b) the CCC's letters may reference items not discussed extensively with the BBGHAD Board, and c) a potential problem exists with the sequencing of permits (CCC, then SLC) proposed by the SLC-- especially where the CCC asks for a complete SLC permit before CCC's consideration of its CDP. The Vice Chair asked the BBGHAD Engineer if he has informed the BBGHAD Board of all the open permit items and, if so, to specify when the open items will be completed.

The BBGHAD Engineer asserted that Moffatt & Nichol has reviewed the "incomplete application" letters, prepared detailed matrixes of the CDP application status, and has not intentionally neglected to mention any open item or items. The BBGHAD Enginner further stated that the "sequencing" issue has been discussed with CCC staff and it has agreed to consider the BBGHAD's project before SLC permits are issued-- contrary to the statement in the most recent "incomplete application" letter.

The Chair and other Board Members expressed the view that, while senior CCC staff may support the project, it is clear that the less senior staff (authors of the "incomplete application" letters) do not favor many aspects of the project. The Vice Chair asserted that the BBGHAD should meet with all appropriate CCC staff to show the BBGHAD's resolve and commitment to complete the project, and to solicit support from all agency staff. The Chair recognized Consultant Marquis, who responded that the BBGHAD appears on the cusp of getting its' application deemed "complete", but also needs coordination from the CCC and SLC. Consultant Marquis added that he does not recommend the BBGHAD to conduct, as advised by the July 12, 2013 letter, additional benthic studies for offshore sand sites that will not be considered for the project.

The Chair stated the need for a comprehensive response to the agencies listing all of the reports and analyses completed to date. In addition, the response should specify whether each "incomplete" item referenced by CCC staff has been completed, partially completed with anticipated completion date, or not completed with the reasoning for same. The Chair further advised that BBGHAD staff meet with senior staff and, if appropriate, commissioners form the CCC and SLC to: 1) resolve inconsistencies between the agency(ies) and the BBGHAD, 2) increase their involvement in the project, and 3) prioritize remaining open items.

The Chair solicited the BBGHAD Engineer for further input; the BBGHAD Engineer had no further input. The Chair solicited Project Counsel for further input. Project Counse stated that senior staff and Commissioners need to be engaged in the project and the BBGHAD should consider a lobbyist to coordinate the necessary meetings and communications. The Chair delegated to the Vice Chair the issue of retaining a lobbyist and a budget not to exceed \$10,000 if the Vice Chair believes it necessary to retain a lobbyist. The Chair further directed BBGHAD staff to finish the necessary reports/analyses, matrixes and letter to the CCC and SLC as soon as possible so that the senior agency staffs could then be engaged.

b. Proposed GHAD Contracting Policy

10. GHAD OFFICER REPORTS

a. Treasurer Report

The BBGHAD Treasurer reported that, as of August 4, 2013, a single BBGHAD member, Barry Smolev, has not yet paid property taxes, including the BBGHAD assessment line item. The Treasurer further reported that the City of Malibu recently reimbursed the BBGHAD another \$50,057 of the assessment monies paid by members and that approximately \$44,000 remains owing from the County. The Treasurer anticipates another distribution form the City on or about August 20, 2013 and should then be in a position to opine on the exact amount owing, if any, by the County and/or Mr. Smolev from the most recent property tax statements.

b. BBGHAD Manager Report

None. The Chair requested Project Counsel to inquire as to ENGEO's recent retainer request.

11. BBGHAD BOARD MEMBER REPORTS

Vice Chair- Vice Chair Grossman reported on recent developments regarding the proposed Trancas Field project.

Hello Ken, The BBGHAD has not submitted enough information as part of their Coastal Development Permit application for us to have a clear understanding of the exact source location, quantity, methodology of extraction, grain size, composition, etc. of the 600,000 cubic yards of inland sand most recently proposed as part of the subject project. Our letter dated July 12, 2013, which was sent to the BBGHAD via mail, states "Until we receive a complete description of the proposed project modification we are unable to identify all informational requirements, however, as a courtesy, we have included preliminary comments which include, but are not limited to, the items contained in Section I and Section II of this letter." At this time, the comments included in section I and II of that filing status letter are intended to be preliminary guidance, as explained in further detail in our letter. However, we cannot provide any additional feedback as to what "will suffice for both the APTR and the CDP application" (as you have stated in your email below) other than the filing requirements extensively detailed in our filing status letter dated February 8, 2013 and the potential filing requirements and preliminary informational guidance detailed in our July 12, 2013 filing status letter update. The documents that you have attached to the emails sent to Steve Hudson of our office, which include 1. A Proposed Trancas Lagoon Study, 2. A

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To clarify, the proposals for the subject studies you sent our agency via email do not constitute informational materials submitted in response to our latest filing status letters. Therefore, CDP application 4-12-043 remains incomplete pending receipt of the filing requirements detailed in our latest filing status letters dated 7/12/13 and 2/8/13. The CCC cannot provide formal comments as to the filing requirements for either the use of the inland quarry sourced sand or any new development proposed in Trancas Lagoon until the these new potential project components are formally included, detailed, and analyzed as part of the subject CDP application. Our staff would be happy to meet with the BBGHAD representatives to discuss the filing status of the application further. If the BBGHAD, yourself, and/or Moffat and Nichol would like to set up a meeting please let Steve or I know and we can check in with Jack Gregg, Lesley Ewing, and Jonna Engel and give you some potential dates when we would all be available.

Also, please note that the State Lands Commission and the CA Coastal Commission have different jurisdictional responsibilities and are tasked with implementing different regulations and policies. As such, sometimes our filing requirements may differ, consistent with California state law. However, our agencies have been coordinating to the best of our ability to promote efficient review of the proposed project and related CDP and lease applications. If you have any further questions or would like clarification on any of these matters please feel free to contact me.


