

Treasure Mountain Festival Parade Rules and Application

- Only the name of the entry sponsor may be displayed on any entry. No other advertising is permitted.
- No political advertising of any kind will be permitted.
- **Entries that pre-register will be given priority.** The 1st entry in each category to register will be the 1st entry in that category to be lined up for the parade. The 2nd entry will be next and so on. If an entry scheduled to go first needs added time they may forfeit their right to go in their assigned slot and the parade chairpersons will reschedule them as deemed necessary.
- Anyone causing issues at the parade assembly area will be reported to security and will be subject to removal from the parade, eviction from the assembly area, and will be subject to further legal action if deemed necessary.

Parade Classes

Class I: FLOATS:

- Floats must follow the festival theme for the specific year.
- Everyone riding on a float must be safely seated or secured. Safety first...

Class II: HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BANDS:

- As the local high school of the sponsoring town, the Pendleton High School Band will be the 1st band in the parade, and will not be judged.

Class III: PRIVATE BANDS AND PLAYING GROUPS:

- The TMF Alumni Band will be the 1st private band in the parade. Bands/Groups will be spaced as much as possible to prevent interference between other marching groups using music.

Class IV: PERFORMING GROUPS: (Twirlers, dance troops)

- Groups will be spaced as much as possible to prevent interference between bands and with other marching groups using music.
- Pertaining to children 6 years of age or younger, the entrant has the option of either allowing children to march with their group (if the child is capable of that walk) or allowing them to ride on a vehicle associated with that group.

Class X: ANTIQUE CARS

- All entries must be model year 1979 or earlier. No entry will be in the parade that is newer than 1979.
- Entries may not be modified in any way i.e. lift kits, lowering kits, etc...
- Paint color changes are acceptable.
- If an original part is no longer available, a more recent years part may be used as long as the factory desired appearance is not altered or changed.

Class XI: ANTIQUE TRUCKS

- Entries must be model year 1979 or earlier. Rules for trucks are the same as rules for cars above.

Class XII: HORSE TEAMS

- All horse teams will be at the end of the parade unless daipers are used.

Class XIII: HORSES

- All horses will be at the end of the parade unless daipers are used.

Class XIV: ANTIQUE FIRE TRUCKS

- All entries must be model year 1979 or earlier. No entry will be in the parade that is newer than 1979. Newer vehicles may be used to transport queens but these vehicles will not be judged or officially entered in the parade.
- Entries may not be modified in any way i.e. lift kits, lowering kits, etc...
- Paint color changes are acceptable.
- If an original part is no longer available, a more recent years part may be used as long as the factory desired appearance is not altered or changed.
