

### **Summer Playgroup Format:**

- Your child will be assigned to a “home-base” classroom that may or may not be the same room that your child had during the school year.
- It is important to remember that the Summer Camp program is a variance on the routine that was experienced by your child during the school year. It is likely that your child will be with different children and teachers in his/her home-base than those that were in his/her classroom during the school year. On the other hand, children in same age groups will share the outdoor times together during a major portion of the day.

### **Medical Forms:**

- If the school does not have a current immunization record on file, please bring an updated copy of your child’s immunization record to the school office on or before your child’s first day of summer camp.

### **Daily Arrival Time:**

- 9:00 a.m. – 9:10 a.m., Monday – Friday.
- Please **PARK and DELIVER** your child to his/her “home-base” classroom each day. Home-bases will be posted on the first day of each session at the office entrance.
- If you arrive prior to 9:00 a.m., please remain with your child in the lobby until doors open at 9:00.

### **Dismissal:**

- 1:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. Please park and enter LOBBY where the children will be waiting with their teacher.
- There is a late pick up charge of \$1.00 per minute for any child picked up after 1:10 p.m.
- If you are in a carpool, please present a written note to the teachers in your child’s home-base. **As always, your child will not be permitted to go home with another child without a written note, or a call to the office.**

### **Dress:**

- Plan to dress your child in a swim suit with a T-shirt or “easy-to-dress” loose clothing as a cover-up.
- Shoes that are rubber soled are appropriate as well as aqua shoes and/or Velcro-strapped rubber sandals that can get wet. **Boots are not allowed.**
- Bring a labeled towel each day and plan for your child to bring a wet towel home each day.

### **Snack:**

- Send a simple **NUT FREE** snack daily and please label. \*Thursdays we will serve popsicles at our bubble party.

**Lunch:**

- Please remember to pack a healthy lunch and drink every day. (No carbonated drinks)
- As a reminder, we have children registered for SAC who have allergies to nut products. In keeping with our promise to serve and protect our children, we ask that lunches be **NUT FREE**. We suggest an alternative to peanut butter is sun butter which can be found at most grocery stores.

**Toilet Training:**

- If your three-year old child is not completely toilet trained, he/she must wear plastic “swim diapers” in order to attend.
- All other children must be independent in their bathroom needs.

**Remember:**

- If your child is not to go home in the usual way, please send a note to that effect and see that it goes to his/her home-base teacher. We will not accept a child's or a friend's verbal message.
