Sister Sharon Tenbarge D.C. wins Mother Teresa Service Award

Sister Sharon was awarded the Mother Teresa Service Award at the Catholic Charities Dinner on May 7. In past years one person received the award from each parish. This year only one individual was selected from each of the five deaneries. Sister Sharon was the recipient for the West Deanery.

Sr. Sharon came to us in the fall of 2009 after serving 38 years as a missionary to the poor in Japan. Since then she served the poor in our Soup Kitchen, through St. Vincent DePaul Society, the Neighborhood Association, the Ozanam Family Shelter, and CAJE. She would walk the streets of Evansville speaking to the homeless offering them respect and love. Sr. Sharon passed away suddenly on November 27, 2014. She was soft spoken but powerful as an advocate for the poor. We truly believe she was a saint in our midst and are happy that she has received this award posthumously.





DISCERNMENT PROCESS FOR THE SELECTION OF PARISH COUNCIL MEMBERS 2015

Saint Anthony and Saint Joseph Parishes will use the process of Discernment for the selection of Parish Council members. This process relies on the help of the Holy Spirit, is open to the broadest possible input from our parish, and provides an opportunity for prayer and reflection at each step of the way.

The Parish Council is a consultative body through which the insights and concerns of the entire Parish Community are brought to the attention of the Pastor and the Parish Team. The spiritual and material welfare of the Parish must be the concern of the Council as well as of the Pastor. The Council assumes responsibilities for specific functions as outlined in the Pastoral Council Bylaws.

Attached is a list of parishioners' names who are eligible to be called to the leadership position of Council member. This list consists of persons who are:

- **at least 18 years of age**
- **has been a member of their Parish for at least two years**
- **active members (regularly come to Church for Mass and share their time, talent and treasure with their Parish)**
- **able to attend meetings.**

We are asking the whole parish to enter into this process. So sometime between now and **Saturday, May 30** please sit in quiet prayer, read through the list of names, and see whom you believe God is calling to the Parish Council. Think of the gift(s) this person would bring to the Council. On **Saturday, May 30 after the 4:00 p.m. Mass or on Sunday, May 31 after the 10:30 a.m. Mass or the 5:00 p.m. Mass** you will be invited to remain in church for a short time to share the name and gift(s) of the person you believe would be a good choice for the Council. These names and gifts will then be used by the future Parish Council for further discernment.
