**YOUTH MINISTRY SUMMER INTERNSHIP**  
*Job Description*

**DEFINITION:**

The Summer Intern(s) shall be a full-time member of the staff serving specifically to assist the Youth Ministries Director to reach both Middle and High school students of Coronado. The Summer Intern(s) must be actively following Jesus Christ, confessing Him as Lord of their life and using their gifts and talent to bring honor and glory to God.

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the Summer Internship Program is to provide an opportunity for young men and women seeking to discern their call to ministry. The intern(s) shall be provided a gracious environment to learn while developing and enriching their leadership skills and utilizing their gifts to reach Middle and High School students.

**ACCOUNTABILITY:**

Accountable, first and foremost to the Lord Jesus Christ then to the Associate Pastor.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. A solid personal relationship with Jesus Christ and an active spiritual walk with God.
2. A passion for students: to know them and see them come to know Christ.
3. An ability to work effectively with students, exhibiting creativity, understanding and patience.
4. A minimum of 1-year experience volunteering in a ministry program.
5. A self-starter who works amicably in conjunction with other student ministry staff and the greater church staff.
6. An ability to organize information, multi-task, and manage the high demands of ministry.
7. Available June — August.

**PRIMARY DUTIES:**

1. Assist in planning, organizing, preparing for, and implementing the Middle and High school Youth Ministry programs (games, lessons, snacks, transportation, announcements, prayer, special events, etc.).
2. Share teaching responsibilities on Tuesday nights and Sunday mornings.
3. Build relationships with students in order to present the gospel of Jesus Christ to them and encourage their growth through the study of scripture, prayer, fellowship and service.
4. Assist in administrative tasks associated with youth ministry (contact work, research field trips, plan transportation, etc.)
5. Special events: Mission trip, Forest Home, Lock-in. Intern(s) is expected to accept leadership responsibilities during each of these events.
6. Have set, but flexible office hours (30+ hours a week).

7. Regularly meet with Associate Pastor to assess teaching skills and overall success of programs.
8. Desirable, but not required: someone who can play or lead the Music Ministry Team during rehearsals.

**REMUNERATION:**

1. Compensation: \$2,400.00
2. Gain practical ministry training and church experience testing their gifts and call to vocational ministry.
3. Develop a deeper understanding of scripture while broadening their theological scope.
4. Possible housing with church family.
5. Possible transportation (bicycle or car, as available)

**MISSION:**

The mission of Graham Memorial Presbyterian Church is to seek and to know Christ and to make Christ known using the great commission of Jesus Christ as our guide.
