**Reverse painting on glass** is an art form consisting of applying paint to a piece of glass and then viewing the image by turning the glass over and looking through the glass at the image. Unlike painting on a canvas, the foreground must be painted before the background and unlike stained glass, it is not intended to hang in a window with light coming through the piece, but rather hang on a wall with a lot of light directed towards it.
