Could your house be a Safety House?

HELP! There are currently only 7 compliant safety houses in the West Greenwood Primary School Area, we need your support to help the children in our community stay and feel safe.

WHAT IS A SAFETY HOUSE?

A safe place for children to go if they feel unsafe, frightened or unsure.

Things which may cause children to knock on a safety house door: Bullying, scared by a dog or animal, injured or lost, frightened or threatened by another person.

REQUIREMENTS FOR A SAFETY HOUSE:

- The front door is visible from the street.
- There is easy access for a child to the front door.
- Your front door is not hidden by a wall, fence or trees.
- A child will not be scared by a dog.
- An adult is usually in or around home at the times children are going to or from school (school drop-offs/ pick-ups expected).

- An adult in the household must hold a Working With Children Card (cost \$11 for volunteers through the program).

If you can answer YES to these questions please contact me for further details or to register your house as a Greenwood Safety House.
