



Nereid Boat Club Public Access Policy

North Ramp

The north ramp and parking area is in the public park administered by the Borough of Rutherford. Please contact the Borough of Rutherford for regulations governing their use.

Nereid Boat Club Grounds

Nereid Boat Club grounds are those within the fence and between the fence and sidewalk. Nereid does not have set hours of operation, but members are generally present early mornings, afternoon/evenings and on weekends.

Members of the public are welcome to use the floating docks for the launching of non-motorized watercraft (e.g., canoes and kayaks) during hours when the gates to the club are open and a Nereid Boat Club member is present. Club rules for safe and courteous use of the docks and river traffic must be observed at all times. Club rules are posted on the bulletin board on the river side of the clubhouse. Gates will be locked when Nereid Boat Club Members are not present.

Access to boathouse and use of rowing shells is for Nereid Boat Club members and their guests only, but all members of the public are invited to join the club and learn to row. Individualized and group lessons are regularly available.
