

W. W. Guillaume was born in 1869 on the Guillaume homestead east of Elk Point. He worked on the Milwaukee railroad on the section crew until starting in business in Elk Point in 1889 operating a Soup-House, He later operated a saloon, until 1917. He was a director and president of The First National Bank.

Mr. Guillaume built the State Theater Building in 1925, and also built what is known as the Guillaume Block in 1900.

He operated the State Theater until his death in 1930.
