The Renfro Variety Store had its beginning in Elk Point, April 12, 1940. The Store first opened under the ownership of Mary and Don Renfro in the building now occupied by Modern Cleaners. Miss Anne Janssen was manager, assisted by Mrs. Maude Bauman.

When the Council Oak vacated the Burlingame Building, east of the State Theater, the Variety Store moved and still remains in that location.

In November of 1947, Naomi and John Beebee became owners of the business and have since enjoyed living in Elk Point, operating Beebee's Renfro Variety Store.
