

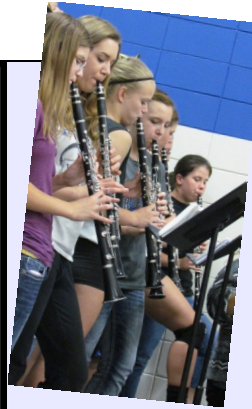
What Can EPJ Offer Your Students?
