

Camp Erin Connecticut

The Cove Center for Grieving Children, a non-profit grief and healing organization dedicated to helping children and families who have experienced the death of a loved one, has partnered with Eluna to facilitate Camp Erin Connecticut.

Camp Erin® is a FREE, weekend long grief support camp to be held on **May 31-June 2, 2019** that is designed to help children and teenagers aged 6-17, who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling or someone close to them.

Camp Erin Connecticut is open to all grieving children statewide.



Camp Erin® Connecticut is a free, weekend bereavement camp for youth who are grieving the death of a significant person in their lives. Children and teens ages 6 to 17 attend a weekend camp experience that combines grief education and emotional support with fun, traditional camp activities. Led by bereavement professionals and caring volunteers, campers are provided a safe environment to explore their grief, learn essential coping skills, and make friends with peers who are also grieving. The Cove Center for Grieving Children will also provide families with long-term support at our family sites.
