Formerly hung within a bespoke mansion in a leafy Main Line suburb, The Barnes Collection is now sheltered in central Philadelphia within an award-winning structure by the critically-acclaimed architects Tod Williams and Billie Tsien. The Collection's founder, Albert C. Barnes, was a famously eccentric patron of the arts who insisted on complete control of his artwork's setting. Accordingly, the move was controversial, not least due to the need to abrogate key terms of Barnes' will.

Join **SHAG** and their special guest, **Dr. Diala Touré**, in a discussion about Philadelphia's most controversial art institution. Dr. Touré and her audience will explore the impact of The Barnes' relocation, the value of the original Collection, and the ways in which art, politics, and personalities can intersect—or collide!

Dr. Diala Touré is a Fine Art appraiser specializing in African art and African diasporic art. Born and educated in Paris, Dr. Touré received her doctorate in History of Art from the University of the Sorbonne.
