What is this training package about?

A key message from inspections - Fully integrating and promoting Equality, Diversity, Inclusion (EDI) and British values in teaching and learning is an essential, integral and central feature of outstanding practice. It engages learners, enriches learning and provides a wide, rich set of experiences, thoroughly preparing learners for life in Britain's complex multicultural society.

This training package provides intensive, in-depth training, developing knowledge, expertise, skills and confidence for equality champions and curriculum leads to act as a source of advice and expertise for staff, to drive forward best practice and become effective change agents in the organisation.

What is included in the training package?

The training package consists of four modules. Collectively, these workshops provide a holistic package to fully integrate EDI and British values in teaching and learning.

They can be accompanied by a one-hour online support session between each module, providing coaching, mentoring and the sharing of expertise to help implement the outcomes of training.

The four workshops are:

- **Module Four** – Taking risks, handling controversial discussions and difficult conversations with confidence
