The School of St. Mary will again offer summer camp programs for three to six year old children from June 16 to July 11! *Crusader Camp's* exciting programs include:

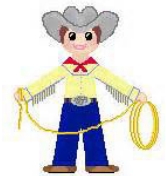
Princesses and Pirates (June 16-20)

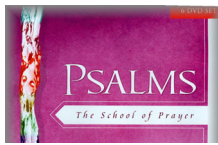

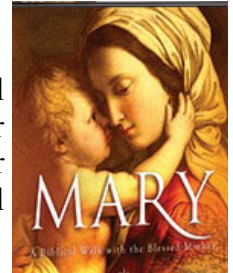
Psalms: The School of Prayer

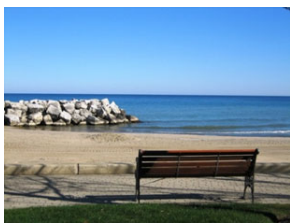
