Our parish will celebrate the Anointing of the Sick within the context of the Eucharist on Sunday, August 10 at Noon in our Church.

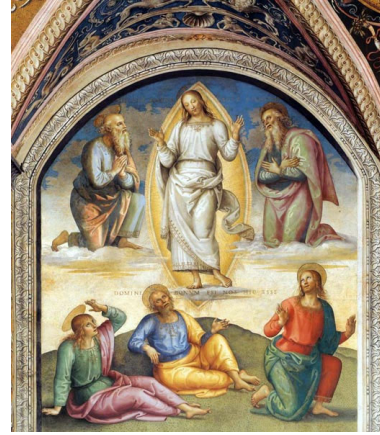

BECOMING CATHOLIC

As pastor of St. Mary's, I am privileged when people share with me their stories of faith. Many people here have shared with me that they became Catholic as adults; some were previously unbaptized, many were baptized Christians but belonged to other communities. A common theme is how the search for God and a relationship with Jesus led them to the Catholic faith.

At this time of year, St. Mary's invites those who are considering becoming Catholic to invest themselves in a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). This process is a blend of prayer, reading and conversations with committed Catholics as well as other people who are seekers that are coming to faith. The RCIA program begins this fall with Father Brendan Guilfoil as the spiritual director. If you are interested in learning more about RCIA, please contact Fr. One comment: God has blessed the Catholic Church with three popes in a row who have made a positive impression on both believers and non-believers. Saint John Paul II, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, and Pope Francis have reached people with a message about the importance of belonging to Jesus Christ and being a member of his body, the Church. It's up to us, here on the local level, to extend an invitation to members of our families and community to become part of the Catholic Church. May the Holy Spirit guide our efforts this year.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

On Sunday, August 10 at the Noon Mass, the priests of our parish will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. The ritual takes place after the homily and consists of the priest placing his hands on the head of the people who are ill, praying over them, and then anointing their heads and hands with blessed oil.

The Quigley Scholars Program Now Accepting Applications!

For High Schoolers Who Want to Learn More about Becoming a Priest

Cardinal George created The Quigley Scholars Program for high school men who want to learn more about the priesthood. Quigley Scholars are recommended by a parish priest, school and family. They are young men who like to help others, often are involved in their parish and apply themselves at school.

What to Expect: Scholars can choose to come to either St. Joseph College Seminary or Mundelein Seminary for a session once a month from September through April. We pray together, attend Mass, have dinner and attend a faith sharing session with the college seminarians.



Scholarships Are Available: Scholars who attend Catholic high schools in the Archdiocese may also apply for a \$2,500 scholarship to help offset the cost of high school tuition. The program is open to teens in Catholic and public high schools, as well as homeschoolers. You can join at any grade level.

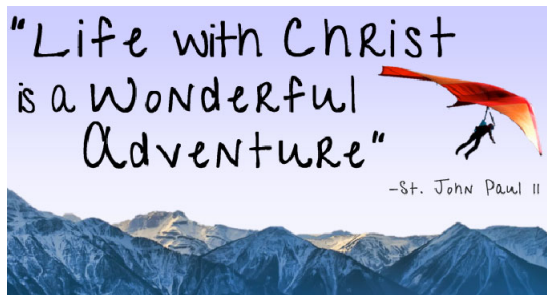
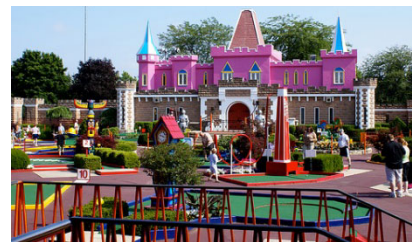

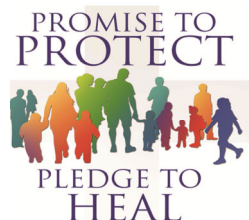
