Pastor's Notes

PRAY FOR IRAQ



Our Holy Father, Pope Francis has been speaking out on behalf of religious minorities in Iraq who are being persecuted and forced to flee from their homes and from Iraq itself. To give some perspective, before 2003 there were one million Christians in Iraq; today there are 150,000. The situation is getting worse and one wonders if any Christians will be able to remain in that country.

The Catholic bishops of the United States have asked all Catholics in our country to observe a day of prayer and fasting for peace with justice in Iraq this coming Sunday, August 17. Please join us for Mass this weekend and spend some time in personal prayer as well for those who are being persecuted.

SERVING THE ELDERLY POOR

The Little Sisters of the Poor will visit St. Mary the weekend of August 23-24. Their community was founded in France by Jeanne Jugan to serve the needs of the elderly poor, a group in society that are too often overlooked or forgotten. Locally, the Little Sisters of the Poor serve at two residential homes in Palatine and in Chicago. They requested a weekend to come to our parish and share with us information about their charism. We will also take up a second collection in support of their work that weekend.

SUMMER PROGRAMS

Since June we have been glad to welcome a number of guest speakers to St. Mary for talks on important topics related to our faith. My thanks especially to Charles Craigmile for his eight-part series on the great teachers of the Church from the first four centuries. We had a terrific response with as many as 100 people joining us on Tuesday evenings. Catholics are very much interested in knowing more about our faith and our parish is committed to providing additional excellent speakers in the coming months. SCHOOL OF ST. MARY

Classes at the School of St. Mary will begin on Monday, August 25. Since 1917, thousands of children have received a quality Catholic education at our parish school. My thanks to our principal, Dr. Venette Biancalana, and the school teachers and staff, for their dedication to Catholic education. Thanks to the parents for their support. Please keep all children who are beginning school this week in your prayers.

A GIFT FROM OUR BIBLE STUDY GROUP

Each spring the members of our parish Bible Study generously make a gift in support of our liturgical life at St. Mary. This spring they designated a financial gift in order to have the tabernacle cleaned and plated. The tabernacle is important in a Catholic church because it contains the reserved Blessed Sacrament. Our silver tabernacle, which was purchased for the parish by Monsignor Shannon in the late 1930s, will temporarily be removed from church so that the restoration company in Winnetka can take it to their shop. The Blessed Sacrament will be reserved for a week in a simple tabernacle. Thank you to the members of the Bible Study for their thoughtfulness.

THE MADONNA

Recently a family in our community very generously donated to St. Mary a beautiful painting of the Virgin Mary, Christ and St. John the Baptist. It is a 200-year-old copy of Raphael's "Madonna della Seggiola" (Mother of the Chair). The original is in the Pitti Palace in Florence (see the image on the bulletin cover); this newly restored copy will be displayed in our church beginning later this month. I have always found that good religious art is a help in praying. I am grateful that this painting has found a home at St. Mary. Many thanks to the donors.

Church of St. Mary Choir News



The **10:30 Choir** will resume rehearsals on Thursday, September 3 at 7:30. The 10:30 choir rehearses weekly on Thursday evenings from 7:30-9:00pm, and sings at the 10:30am Mass on Sundays, as well as Christmas, Holy Week, Easter, and special occasions. The 10:30 Mass is an SATB choir (soprano, alto, tenor and bass) which has a long tradition of singing high quality church music, and new members are always welcome. This choir is open to those of high school age and above. No audition is required, although people with previous choral experience are especially encouraged to join us.

Fauré Requiem

This year, All Souls Day is on a Sunday, November 2, and I am planning to have the choir sing the Fauré Requiem on Saturday, November 1. If you would like to participate in singing this sublime piece of sacred music, we will be rehearsing it on the 7:00pm Thursday evenings prior to All Souls. If you are hesitant to commit to an entire year of choir participation, this would be a good way to see how a shorter term commitment might work for you. The rehearsals will be on Thursday evenings from 7:30-8:30 (followed by “regular” choir rehearsal from 8:30-9:15) from September 18 through October 30 (“dress” rehearsal on October 30). If you are interested in singing the Fauré and would like to get an early start on learning it, I have scores available now. If you’d like to have a score, please feel free to come up to the choir loft after Mass, or contact me via e mail or phone, and I can sign one out to you.

I am planning to start two new ensembles this fall:

A *Women’s Schola*, which will sing at 5:00pm Saturday Mass, twice monthly. This group is open to all women of the parish, and will rehearse once a month, and also for one hour before the 5:00pm Masses for which they will sing.

A *Handbell Choir*, which will play once a month and for special occasions during the year. This group is open to all, and rehearsal dates and times will be determined based on the response of potential participants.




Psalms: The School of Prayer
