## Pastor's Notes



### THE TRANSFIGURATION

The gospel passage this weekend at Mass is Mark's account of the Transfiguration of Jesus. By allowing Peter, James and John to see Him in a glorified manner, Jesus is strengthening them for the scandal of the passion and cross. I can understand why Peter wanted to linger on the mountain and prolong the moment of glory, remaining in peace and friendship forever. Yet, Jesus leads the three apostles down the mount and continues pressing on toward Jerusalem. Jesus must suffer His passion and death for the forgiveness of our sins, so that He can present to the Father a world that is redeemed. This week, I invite you to reflect on this question: *When were the times in life that God has strengthened you in the face of carrying the cross?*

### THE FAMILY

This October, Pope Francis will gather with bishops representing the Church around the world for a synod (gathering) on the family in the modern world. Information about the synod is available there. Also, Archbishop Cupich has requested that all the parishes distribute a survey to the lay faithful to complete. Archbishop Cupich will soon be offering a reflection on the family today to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. He would welcome input from the faithful in preparing his remarks.

The survey is available in the church and parish office. Please note that the survey is not an opinion poll. Rather, this is a time of discernment; where is God moving and calling us at this moment with regard to family life? Please finish the survey by Friday, March 6 and return to St. Mary's office. Your comments will be synthesized and forwarded to the Archbishop's staff. Thank you.

### THE WEEK THAT WAS

Last week was a remarkable time for our parish. Ash Wednesday saw almost three thousand people present themselves to be signed with the cross and begin the Lenten journey that leads to Easter. Several hundred people approached the Lord for the forgiveness of their sins between Friday's Day of Grace, and the penance service for high school teens on Sunday. Friday evening saw a vibrant group from the Young Adult Ministry of Lake County join parishioners in praying the Stations of the Cross. Over five hundred people came to enjoy our parish Fish Fry on Friday night. I mention all of this because they are signs of life in our parish and in our community. Let's continue to make Lent 2015 a time of openness to God's grace and mercy.

We were probably very young at the time of our first confession. Inevitably, someone—a teacher or a parent—told us, “**Tell** your sins to the priest.” Ever since that time, we may have been reluctant or we may have been relieved, but we have always known what we must do. 




