Pastor's Notes



ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

Forty days after Christ rose from the dead, He ascended into heaven and took His place at the right hand of God the Father. Jesus Christ, who is both God and man, brings our humanity with him into heavenly glory. The liturgy today reminds us that where Christ has gone, we hope to follow. If the apostles felt disoriented when they no longer saw the Risen Christ on earth as He had appeared to them for forty days, they would swiftly be reoriented by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. During this coming week, I encourage you to meditate on the mystery of heaven: what do you hope it will be like to be in the endless presence of the Holy Trinity, the Blessed Mother, the angels and the saints?

PARISH FAMILY ROSARY

The month of May is dedicated to Our Lady. Praying the rosary frequently is a marvelous devotion that can help us become closer to Jesus and Mary. Complimentary booklets to help you pray the rosary are at the doors of our church. I will lead parishioners in praying the rosary together on Wednesday May 20, at 6:40pm. Also, a reminder, the rosary is prayed Monday-Saturday after the 8:00 am Mass.

A choir of nine voices will perform music by Palestrina, Mozart, Gounod, Duruflé, and other composers until 7:45pm; we will then celebrate Benediction.

PRAYING FOR THOSE LIVING WITH CANCER

Recently I spoke with a woman who is being treated for colon cancer (stage four). She mentioned that Tom Brokaw, the journalist, has a new book coming out concerning his own bout with cancer. The book is titled: "A Lucky Life Interrupted." The woman questioned whether or not the word "interrupt" was suitable because it implies that, if treatment of the disease is successful, life can be resumed as it once was. The woman shared that, even if she survives, cancer has not simply interrupted her life, it is changing the course of her life.

There are many people in our community who are struggling with cancer. Some people are public about their illness; some are much more private. All of the people appreciate being prayed for. On Saturday, May 30, I am traveling with a group of parishioners to Our Lady of Sorrows Basilica on the west side of Chicago for a half day of prayer and pilgrimage. The national shrine of St. Peregrine, patron saint of cancer patients, is in that historic church. If you would like to join us, contact Dan Cheely of our staff. 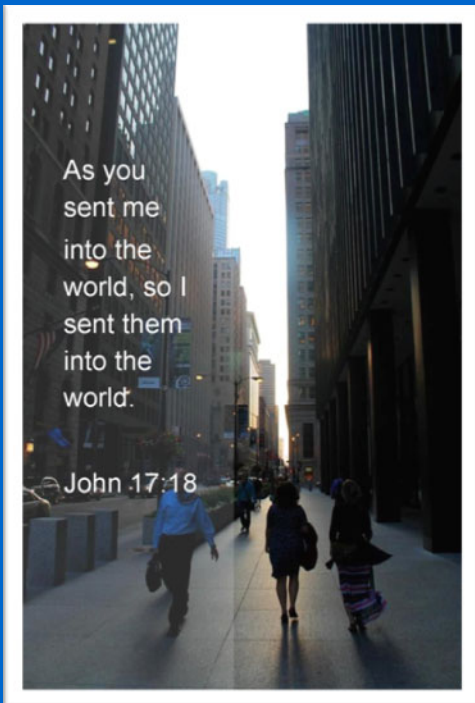


