Pastor's Notes



PENTECOST

Today we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost, fifty days after Easter. Far from being simply an attractive epilogue to the death and resurrection of Jesus, Pentecost is its very completion and goal. During His last hours with His apostles, Jesus' thoughts turned again and again to an event which was to be the focus on which the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, the Resurrection and Ascension were to converge: the descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Pentecost is the climax of God's pursuit of us. It's appropriate that it should end in a tumult of exultant sound and the flashing of fire. Instead of just leaving us a moral code and a collection of miracle stories, God sends the Holy Spirit to dwell within us so that it can be truly said that God lives in us and we live in Him. In John 20:22 the Spirit is beautifully depicted as the breath of the Risen Christ. Just as God breathed into the nostrils of the first man the new breath of life (see Genesis 2:7), the Lord now breathes into our soul the new breath of life, His intimate essence. The Trinity now dwells in us. Alleluia!

CONGRATULATIONS

Last Sunday I was in Chicago at St. Alphonsus Church for the first Mass of Fr. Michael Grzesik. It was wonderful to see him celebrate the Mass with such great joy surrounded by his family, friends and brother priests. Fr. Grzesik will join us as an associate pastor at St. Mary on July 1.

Then in the afternoon I was at Holy Name Cathedral as Bishop Francis Kane ordained Bob Thomas and thirteen other men as permanent deacons. Congratulations to Bob and his wife Marietta and their family. I look forward to Bob's service as a deacon here at St. Mary.

As Catholics we know that ordination takes place when a bishop lays his hands on the head of the candidate and intentionally ordains him as a deacon, priest or bishop. The "laying on of hands" is a brief, silent gesture followed by a prayer. Whenever I participate at an ordination liturgy, I am struck by the fact that the "laying on of hands" began with the apostles, and has been repeated in every ordination of a deacon, priest or bishop for the past two thousand years. I hope that the Lord continues to call young people to serve the Church and that they generously respond to Christ.

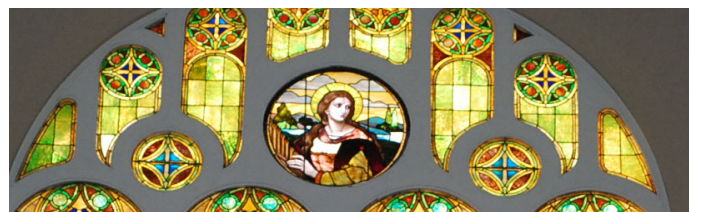
An Inquiry into the Life & Teachings

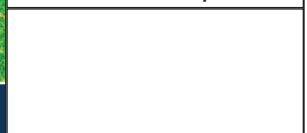




